




Madeira's Got Talent

Date & Place

On 17th April.

The school indoor Amphitheatre - 11:40 to 13:30.

Eligibility

Open to all the students from the 5^{th} to the 12^{th} grade.

Groups or individual performances are accepted.

Each participant cannot perform in more than 2 acts.

Pre-registration is required (ask one of your language teachers for an application).

Types of Performances Permitted

Musical performance

Poetry or dramatic reading

Comedy

Acting

<u>Rules</u>

Performances are in one of the foreign languages studied at school: English, French or Spanish.

Individual performances are limited to 5 minutes. Group performances are limited to 10 minutes

Groups may have a maximum number of 4 members.

Music, jokes, language and costumes must be suitable for all ages.

Acts are responsible for their own music, instruments and props.

Procedures

Applications must be delivered until the 10^{th} April (hand them in to your language teacher).

All performances will be grouped according to grades: from the 5^{th} to the 12^{th} grade.

All performers must arrive at the school Amphitheatre at 11:15 o'clock.

The talent show will begin at 11:45 o'clock.

The judge panel will be composed by 3 teachers and 2 students.

Each performance will showcase their talent in front of the judges and an audience (teachers and students).

Judges will score each performance.

Each performance will have a maximum possible score of 5 points from each judge.

The total performance score will be out of 25 possible points.

Judges will base their evaluation on the following Categories:

- Language proficiency
- Quality of act
- Originality
- Content
